### Requirements

- Member of DKG in good standing for at least 3 years at the time of application
- Must be accepted into a graduate degree program in an approved institution of higher learning
- Meet reasonable standards of general health, personality, scholarship, professional and community service
- Must evidence potential for future service to Delta Kappa Gamma
- Personal comments and references should show promise of distinction in one's chosen field
- Will be considered on the basis of active participation on the local and state levels of Delta Kappa Gamma

## Professional Growth Stipends

### Description

Stipends will be granted to members of Delta Kappa Gamma, Alpha Zeta State working individually or as a team member in the amount of up to \$1000 per selected application for the following:

- Professional growth
- Personal development
- Research
- Travel related to one's field of work
- Educational and/or community service projects
- Conference attendance related to one's field

### Criteria

- Must be a member in good standing with at least a full year of membership
- Team projects require at least one member to be a DKG member
- Involvement in DKG and length of service will be taken into consideration
- Should show potential for professional growth and leadership development

## The Margaret Abel Scholarship Award



**Margaret Abel, Gamma Chapter, was a leader and outstanding woman educator**

The Margaret Abel Scholarship Fund is to provide grants-in-aid to assist outstanding women preparing to enter the education profession. The award is in the amount of \$1000 and will be awarded to one qualified individual at the Alpha Zeta State Convention each spring.

### Criteria

- Must be a U.S. citizen, a resident of New Jersey, and enrolled in a four-year college or university in New Jersey.
- Must be a female graduate or undergraduate student who has begun her professional program leading to an initial teaching certification.

### Requirements

- Application Form
- Official transcript: 3.9 average required
- Three letters of recommendation (2 letters from professionals in the field of education and 1 personal reference)
- Resumé
- A 500 word essay indicating desire to become a teacher and attributes that make you a worthy recipient
